During the play of these games it is advisable to use visual, auditory, kinesthetic, methods such as.

The use of various exhibitions during the teaching of foreign languages gives effective results. For example, it is useful to point out fruits such as bananas and apples and mention their color at once, so that the new words can be easily memorized by the child, while drawing a picture of these fruits on the board. through which it will be possible to draw their attention. This not only helps the child to learn foreign languages without difficulty but also helps to reinforce the knowledge the children have learned. As the brain activity of young children continues to develop steadily, their brain activity has been fully formed. Childhood is the best time to develop a person's thinking ability. It should be noted that we need to increase the child's interest in language from an early age. It is necessary to encourage to speak, even if it is a mistake, so that the child can speak boldly without fear. It should also be noted that competitions among children play an important role, as children need to develop a sense of competition from an early age. But, one of the most popular tools for both teachers and parents is cards for learning English. After all, they are so easy and simple to use for many entertaining games in English. During games with cards, memory, imaginative thinking, and the child's logic develop. In addition, when talking about the habits of one or another animal depicted on the card, the child can jump, run, stomp his feet and clap his hands, thereby doing a little exercise is necessary for the full development of children of any age. Considering that visual-figurative thinking prevails in preschoolers, colorful pictures are suitable for such games. With their help, you can play and learn words in English, learning more about the world around you. It is recommended to allocate no more than 15 minutes for one game with cards: this time will be enough to support the motivation for learning English, repeat all the necessary words. children, the fewer cards should be in a row (for 3-4 years, six cards are enough). When teaching children, do not forget about their encouragement. Even a simple sticker received by a child for his efforts in class will stimulate his work in future.
